Advice for Carer				

**Advice for Carer** 

1. Safely assist or lift the person from the floor Before you lift the person:

> If there are signs of deterioration, select 'Start Again' to re-assess.

> This guidance covers most, but not every possible, post falls scenario. If there are other

clinical concerns, discuss whether it is safe to lift the person with a senior member of staff.

2. Where possible, observe the person for at least 24 hours for any new symptoms
